This would be the first time in the history of Maharashtra that an Academic institution is being setup, managed and run by an Academician.

When we were given a chance to run an entire education institution without any intervention from management as well their help, we brought many laurels and achieved many milestones to the Institution. We became the first **ISO 9001: 2008** certified institute in the state of **Maharashtra**.



This progress and experience gave us ample amount of confidence and inspiration to march ahead into this field and try to radicalize the education system. To achieve this, we need to start from the grass root level i.e. from the **pre-formative years of schooling**. We like to bring a point to your notice is that all the achievements attained by us were not through conventional methods but due to proper planning, modern methodology of administration and teaching.

This **Education institution (Jahnvis Multi Foundation - JANA GANA MANA CBSE SCHOOL & VANDE MATARAM DEGREE COLLGE)** is already have meritorious students of **DOMBIVLI** to represent themselves at the national level and have a huge representation in **International** market as well. This is not strictly with respect to academic qualities but also in co-curricular activities too. By effectively implementing our time tested administration and modern teaching methodology we can create a chapter in the History of Modern education system. Dombivli has the highest number of middle class people around Suburb in the Central region. Every year many meritorious students go to other suburbs for higher education because of lack of quality education and schools. In Dombivli 93% are filled with many different types of communities. Till date there has not been any violent incident in Dombivli, which proves the high level of harmony and tolerance than any other city.

We are Middle class hard working Academic people who want to change the education system of our country in the best possible way and help our country to attain its former glory which it had during ancient times. In short we want our children to have the best education practices available to them in this modern world. Only

faith, well wishes, confidence and blessings from **GOD ALMIGHTY** will be the guiding spirit to become the pioneers of modern education system.

Hope this letter gives a very transparent view of our goals, intentions and objectives in this regard. Your decision and consent would prove to be turning point to bring the much awaited revolution in Indian Education System and the dreams of our beloved President His Excellency Hon'ble Dr. A P J Abdul Kalam will be realized.

The Jahnvis Multi Foundation is a Trust registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 by the Charity Commission, Mumbai having the corporate office at 8 – 15, Everest Shopping Centre, 3rd Floor, Opp. Railway Station, and Dombivli (West). The Registration of the Trust is MH / 1117 / 02 & F / 11441 / Thane dated 06-02-2003. The trust has formed with the intension of imparting education to all, particularly for the students coming from poor and middle class family.

The Trust is also having FCRA certificate vide bearing No.083990132 dated 09-02-2007. Apart from this Trust has also obtained a tax exemption certificate from Income Tax u/s 80-G as per the certificate dated 16-08-2007 valid permanently.

The trust is running Donation Free Jana Gana Mana CBSE School and Vande Mataram Degree College of Arts, Commerce and Science (Affiliated to University of Mumbai) at JMF Sanskriti Vihar, Telkoswadi, Dr.Nemade Road, Old Dombivli, Kopar, Dombivli (West), Thane – 421 202 and it is walk-able distance from Dombivli and Kopar Stations. The construction for the school and college building is already started to accommodate the maximum students of under privileged in particular and privileged in general.



The trust had purchased the plot reserved for education purpose by the Kalyan-Dombivli Municipal Corporation from a renowned builder. The construction of the school and college building is completed. A project loan from Corporation Bank was availed by the Trust.

The total estimated construction cost was near about twelve crores for 1st phase (Ground to 4th floor). The 2nd phase will be constructed in days to come (5th to 8th floor) We are not collecting any kind of donation or deposits from parents for admission from Play group to Graduation.

The School / college are giving importance to Sports as like academic activities. We have already made arrangement for outdoor games like Foot-ball, Volley-ball, Basket-ball, cricket etc. and indoor games like Table Tennis, Caroms etc. Also making provision for gymnasium with necessary machineries, Laboratories with all equipment's and well equipped Library. The building will also have one general lift, one capsule lift and one fire lift.

On 15th February, 2016, JMF also adopted **KOPAR STATION** form Central Railway with due authentic legal permission of the Authority of Central Railway for the purpose of its beautification, Cleanliness, Safety & Security of the passengers.

The JMF's Trust College situated in Dombivli organizes Rojgar-Mela at college level where the students get placements. We also have a tie-up with 20 plus companies viz. **CLUB MAHINDRA** under Corporate Social Responsibility is organising 4 Jumbo Job Melas for entire Thane and Mumbai Suburb whereas more than 1000s of Job Seekers will have an right choice to select from 100s of companies for Employment purpose.

The college is also the center for National Level Exam Center viz., Annamalai University Exams were conducted for students.

Trust has also organized National Level **RASHTRAJYOT PURASKAR** in 27th March, 2010 for the first time in each area of importance where more than 6 national level awardees' were awarded.



Also in 2014, **GRAMJYOT PURASKAR** a state level award function held at Dawasa, Nagpur for those who are working for the betterment and upliftment of poor farmers in particular & Community in general.

In 21st March, 2015, the second ceremony of the National Level **RASHTRAJYOT PURASKAR** was successfully held for another six awardees'.

The trust also opened one state board school at Dawasa, Narkhed, Nagpur from 19th July, 2014. There is no any other school in the 20 Km of radius. Hence all these 20 villages have got benefited because of the school. More than 125 students have been admitted in the first year and 180 students are enrolled in 2015. The school has provided books, Uniforms, shoes etc. to all the students on free of cost.

The school also provided the new technology with Talking Pen and Talking Books to the students. Playing equipment's for children also made available in the school. Not collected any type of fees from any students. Training was given to Dawasa School teachers by our Mumbai teachers.

The trust has constructed the school building with all facilities with all modern technologies for the students. The school in Dawasa is designed in such a way that it has the Open-Stage facility cum small Auditorium cum Assembly hall where school's cultural events, workshops, seminars as well as villagers can also perform wedding ceremony and even small functions for the villagers can be placed as per the need. It is available almost free for the below poverty line community.

The trust not only running the donation free school and college, but also adopted four villages and done cleanliness, health & hygienic of that particular villages. On 19th April, 2013 more than hundred cataract operations were done in that villages. Three times, the Health checkup camps were conducted. All the senior citizens were felicitated and given cloths, kurtha's to all of them.



Impact of village adoption attracted nearby villagers who started approaching trust for adoption of their villages. This motivated trust members to do something for Dawasa and nearby villages beyond just the adoption of villages. The government's skill development programme inspired trust members to think on livelihood projects, which can make these villages self-sustainable. Trust identified 25 villages which are situated in Taluka Narkher. Trust already has a ready infrastructure, school building constructed in 2014. The same building can be used for multiple facilities to help around 40-50 thousand villagers staying near-by. Hence JMF will roll-out long term skill development programme in association with other agencies. The trust is also in the verge of commencing the Skill Development Programme.

The aim of the project is to reach to the masses and under-privileged people of the society. Our aim is to make them skill based and they can stand on their own feet and earn for their family. Objectives of the project:

- Need-based training programme for 300+ youth/women (12 months)
- Hand-holding of students over next six months either to help them getting employed or to start their own business.
- Partnering with agencies based in metro cities for market generation of the product developed by attendees.
- The benefit of the project will also be enjoyed by 4-5 Taluka viz. Katol, Karanja, Warud, etc.

The project is especially in Vidarbha region which is facing a challenge of Drought since years. Most of the farmers committed suicide from the Vidarbha region only. The major reason for the same is absence of opportunities to generate ancillary income. If the villagers are trained on need-based skill programme like food-processing, plumbing, carpentry; will help them to generate additional source of income. This additional source of income will remove farmers/ farmer's family member's dependents on only farming income for their livelihood.



The trust is working in this area since 2009. The basic administrative infrastructure is available in the form of trust's English medium school. The trust will conduct basic seminars in individual villages for identifying and enrolling the students. Final list will be scrutinized by the common body representing trust member and local authorities.

Selection criteria will be prioritizing as follows:

- Family member of farmer who committed suicide.
- Backward community.
- Under-privileged/ below poverty line, etc.

The trust has been planning the implementation in two stages:

Stage I: Pre-course requirements handled by existing staff members and additional contractual staff

Stage II: Execution of programme by contractual/ permanent additional staff. Monitoring of the programme will be handled by existing staff/ trust committee.

The expert team (experienced staff members from trust's school/college) will identify the requirements/ guidelines set by National Skill Development Organization and Maharashtra Skill Development Organization.



Stages involved in implementation of project:

- Designing of courses, developing of syllabus
- Identifying experts faculties
- Listing/ sourcing basic infrastructure required e.g. computers, other equipment's like food processing machineries, etc.
- Developing academic calendar
- Awareness seminars in villages for importance of skill development programmes.
- Pre-admission interviews
- Finalizing list of students
- Monitoring of courses
- Market linkage for students
- Employment camps
- Educational tours/ seminars in Industries

Courses specifically are skill based viz., Mobile Repairing; Cooler, Fridge, T.V. Repairing; Driver cum Mechanic; Beauty Therapy and hair Styling; Accounting Assistance Using Tally; DTP & Print Public Assistance; MSCIT; Plumbing & Carpentry; Fruit and vegetable processing; Supply chain management, etc.

The trust had already applied for accreditation with Maharashtra Skill Development Courses. Within months' time the approval is expected which will allow us to issue our own certificate.

The brief glimpses of that project's impact:

- Create ancillary income source
- Women Empowerment and promote educational rights that each and every girl child has by birth.
- Cast eradication when all the people residing over their will work together, take training together, etc.
- To control migration of people who migrate due to unfavorable conditions, less or no means of earning livelihood, etc.
- To preserve community's traditional skills and by adding some new innovation with new technology, etc.
- The food processing area will try to work on orange which is locally available. The location which we choose is considered as highest orange grower in India.
- Such courses may give thought to produce by-products from orange.
- We believe in best practices which we implement by adding values.

- We want to attach these trainees directly to the industries.
- As per the needs of the industries around we will provide them the base for the entry in the industry. We will make changes in the pedagogy and make them fully trained so that they may not require any further training as a trainee in the industry.
- By this, we can save lakhs of rupees by safeguarding the efforts of employers that provides training to the employees in these days of competitive world.

There are also some challenges to overcome:

- A first challenge is to get connected with the industrial world and make them connect to the project.
- Getting the trainee being employed at the good place.
- Break social taboos and Make them involved in this training without extra burden on their life styles.
- We need to hire experts of various fields to the place of interest to provide them training at best possible means.
- To build self-confidence within themselves which they may get filled by taking part in this kind of training programmes held from our courses.

Past few years the trust is running donation free CBSE/State Board school and Degree College in Dombivli. With the excellent skill set of managing resources trust started English medium school in Dawasa, Nagpur. The founders' developed these complete infrastructure in their individual capacity which itself is an indication of developing self-sustainable projects.



We all are human beings and family is the first priority. We are engaged in such a kind of projects where we prove ourselves that Nation is our identity and citizens our extended family for which we are surviving from the inception of our educational trust. We are exercising this practice as it is in our blood and muscles. To implement the belief of nationality our all projects named by National Anthem/ National Song viz. Jana Gana Mana School and Vande Mataram College.
